What is concrete and observable to us is not culture per se, but the differences and similarities in human behavior. We see these expressed in actions, thoughts, rituals, traditions and the like. We see manifestations of "culture" but never culture itself. Understanding our own culture and that of those we assist is of the utmost importance to effectively serve the Latino population
